

Morck Ecuador Budget

This budget reflects the cost for 2 adults and two children deployed to the Diocese of Central Ecuador. As one adult will be an Appointed Missioner and the other a Volunteer for Mission, the National Church's Mission Personnel Office will provide for medical and dental coverage, monthly stipend of \$500, round trip airfare, stipend for moving expenses, and language learning stipend. Another account has unknown funds for children's education. CLAI has committed to covering the costs of housing. The Diocese of Central Ecuador will contribute something to the work-related transportation costs.
